1	Newbies Jumping All Heights <i>No weaves</i>	10.45am	One Ring. Courses will be run in order of increasing jump height. Dogs may run at the height they are comfortable at. One 'refusal' permitted. Course time will be one minute.
2	Newbies Agility All Heights <i>No weaves or seesaw</i>	1.00pm	
3	Practice Round <i>With weaves + seesaw</i>	2.15pm	

ELIGIBILITY: Dogs must be over 15 months old. Includes dogs currently competing in Kennel Club Grades 1 and 2; and dogs which have not yet competed at an Agility Show on 7th July (including if their KC entry level will be Grade 3 due to Handler or owners previous wins).

PRIZES: Clear Round Rosettes in Jumping and Agility Classes. First Place Rosette for each height in classes 1 and 2. Judges Special Rosettes. Other surprises! Presentation at the end of each class.

CLASS DEFINITIONS: **Agility:** may include contact equipment (except the See-saw), Jumps, Long Jump, Tyre, and Tunnels. **Jumping:** can include everything but Contact Equipment and weaves. **Practice Round:** may include Agility equipment, plus a reduced height see-saw and weaves.

JUMP HEIGHTS: 250MM; 350MM, 450MM, 550MM

ENTRY FEE: **£10 for three classes.**

EQUIPMENT: The show will be run on Dogs Actfully Club Training Equipment. Timing will be manual stopwatch.

DIRECTIONS: Please see our website www.dogsactfully.co.uk for link to Maps. From Shaldon/Ringmore Hearn Field Entrance is on your right before you get to Coombeinteignhead. From Newton Abbott go through Coombeinteignhead and ignore the small left fork signed Coombe Cellars. Entrance to Hearn Field is on the left in about 500m.



SHOW RULES

No Stress! Our show is meant to be a fun, no stress introductory level event so please come and enjoy it. This is part of a family fun event. No harsh handling or verbal abuse or the handler may be asked to leave the show.

Dogs on lead please around the vicinity of the show except in the rings. The designated exercise area is the small area of beach (unfortunately high tide is midday). This can be accessed via a gate and steps at the bottom of the field (mid way) or in the bottom left corner (by Combe Cellars Pub).

Bitches in season may be brought to the show ground but must be kept away from the ring areas.

Dogs in cars on hot days: Please ensure your dog has shade, ventilation and plenty of fresh water. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

Food – may not be carried in the hand in the Agility and Jumping Classes. No ‘crumbly’ food to be taken in the ring for any class and any food must be secure (ie: in a fully closed container or zipped pocket) while running so as not to spoil other dogs’ runs.

Not for Competition entries/Training in the ring (NFC): Dogs may be run as **NFC** (not for competition) in the Jumping and Agility class as long as they are entered as such on the form (may be altered at the show prior to running). If entered **NFC** a silent toy may be taken into the ring and training in the ring will be permitted and the handler will have the course time (60 seconds) on the equipment. NFC entries will not be eligible for 1st Place Rosettes but may be awarded a Judges Special.

Running orders - Each class will run in ascending order of Jump Height. Handlers need to be at the ringside during their chosen height, prior to the next height being set. If a handler misses their height window, they may be allowed to run at the end of the class at the Judge’s discretion and subject to time availability.

Confirmation of Entry: provided a mobile telephone number has been provided a text will be sent confirming safe receipt of your entry.

Entries received after Closing: in the event that an entry is received after closing of entries, if an SAE has been provided the cheque will be torn in half and returned to the handler. Otherwise the cheque will be destroyed and a confirmation text sent to the handler provided a mobile number has been given.

Pick up after your dog – anyone found not picking up their dog’s poops anywhere on Hearn Field may be asked to leave the show.

Cancellation and defraying unavoidable costs – in the event that the show is cancelled due to events beyond our control we reserve the right to defray any unavoidable expenses prior to refunding show entries.

Entries at your own Risk: all entries are at your own risk and accepted on the basis that handlers and owners understand and fully accept the risks of injury to themselves and their dogs of participating in canine sporting events and expressly absolve dogsactfully, the show officials and the venue owners of all liabilities or financial responsibilities arising from injury.

Infectious Diseases: handlers shall not bring to the Show any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the Show, or which may be coughing contagiously or suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare.

Special Marking: One ‘refusal’ will be permitted in a run. If a dog does not complete an obstacle, this will result in elimination. The dog will be allowed the course time in the ring. There will be no up-contacts faulted unless the dog has ascended from the side of the ramp past the line of the contact. Striding over the up-contact will not be marked.

Equipment: The show will be run on Dogs Actfully Club Training Equipment. This may not be exactly KC competition standard. For example the Dog Walk Trestles are slightly lower height and the width of the long jump sections are slightly below KC specifications.

Closing Date for Entries: Postmark 23RD June (or when Limit is reached if earlier)
